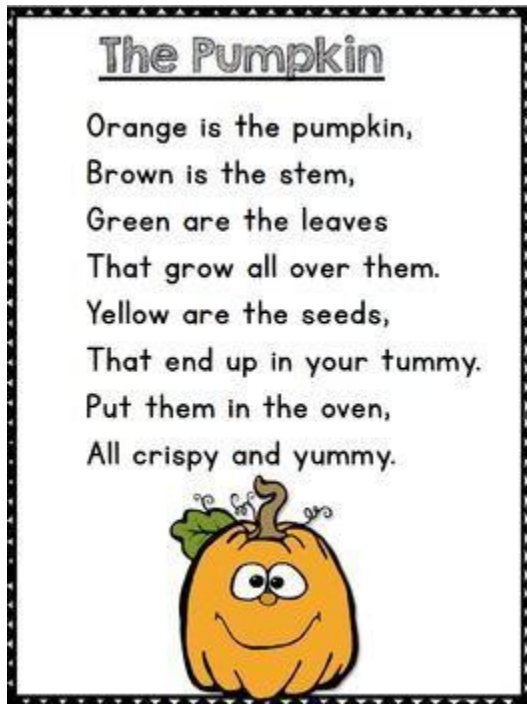

Recipe of the Month

Banana Ghost **INGREDIENTS** • Bananas • Mini Chocolate Chips **INSTRUCTIONS** 1. 1. Peel bananas and cut them in half in the middle. You may need to slice a little extra off the flat end so that it is flat enough to stand up. 2. 2. Place mini chocolate chips skinny tip into the banana so that the flat end is facing out. 3. 3. Make two eyes and a mouth with the chips. 4. Serve with whole grain crackers

Drop Off & Pick Up Concerns

Have your child ready to get out of the car, coat on and seat belt off with "Have a great day!" hugs and kisses given. This keeps the line moving smoothly. Also, in cold weather this helps our teachers and volunteers from freezing! Please have your child's car seat situated on the passenger side of the car. This keeps children safer as we do not want children walking between cars. Siblings should not be left in cars while parents walk in to drop off children. At pick up time, please pull ahead out of the pick up line to buckle your child into their car seat. This will help keep the line moving quickly and smoothly.
