Cinnamon sugar

Margarine

Mini marshmallows

Cookie sheet

Hot pads

### Instructions/Discussion

Easter is celebrated because it is when Jesus died on the cross for our sins, and then 3 days later he rose from the dead. When Jesus' friends and family came to the place where Jesus was buried, he was not there. His tomb was empty.

Flatten out the whole grain bread into a circle. Dip the marshmallows into melted butter/ margarine then in the cinnamon sugar. Place marshmallow in the center of the bread. Fold the bread over the marshmallow and seal. Roll the dough ball in melted butter and then the cinnamon sugar. Bake for 10-15 minutes at 350 degrees.
