PARENT'S NIGHT OUT

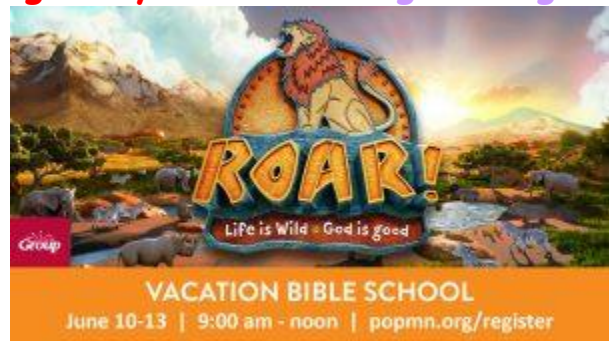
Sat May 11 5:00-8:00
