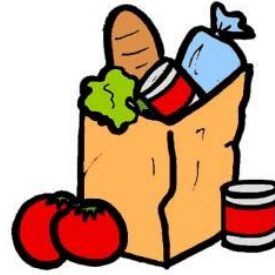

FALL FOOD DRIVE

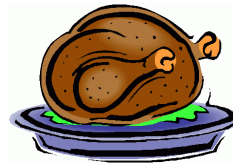

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Cranberry Jam

1. Wash and sort the cranberries.
2. Mix 1 cup of sugar and 1 cup of water. Stir to DISSOLVE the sugar as you bring it to the boil.
3. Add cranberries and return to boil. Reduce heat and gently boil until the cranberries pop (about 10 minutes).
