Your children may have come home talking about going to see P. Mooney. P. Mooney is a language arts program used here at C.D.L.C. The children visit P. Mooney (a puppet) once every two weeks for a half hour. There will be stories, lessons about personal safety, bike safety and much, much more.

PLAYGROUND

We will be going outside every day possible. Be sure to send your child in play clothes, appropriate shoes and a warm jacket when needed.

DROP OFF & PICK UP CONCERNS

- Have your child ready to get out of the car, coat on and seat belt off, last hugs and kisses given. This keeps the line moving smoothly. Also, in cold weather this helps our volunteers and staff from freezing!
- Please have your child's car seat situated on the passenger side of the car. This keeps children safer. We do not want children walking between cars.
- We will come in from drop off promptly at 9:00 AM and 12:45 PM.
- Siblings should not be left in cars while parents walk in to drop off older children.
- At pick up time please pull ahead out of the carpool line to buckle your child into their car seat. This will help to keep the line moving quickly and smoothly.

LABEL, LABEL, LABEL

Please be sure to label any notes with your child's name, teacher and the session that your child attends. Lastly, please remember to label all clothing, coats, hats, backpacks, etc. worn by your child.

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TUITION

Your October tuition payment was due on September 1st. Remember you are always paying a month ahead. Any account not paid by the 15th of each month will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Please send the tuition check attached to the outside of the school bag, so that it is visible immediately. Also be sure to put your child's name in the memo line of your tuition check to ensure proper credit to your child's account.
